## Viola Scales

Fingering suggestions are included. The student may choose to use alternate fingerings.

G Major Scale  $\bullet = 80$

The G Major Scale is presented in 6/8 time with a tempo of 80. The first system consists of two staves: the left staff is in bass clef and the right staff is in treble clef. Fingerings are indicated by numbers 0-4 above or below notes. Breath marks (V) are placed above the first and fourth measures of each staff. The second system also consists of two staves: the left staff is in treble clef and the right staff is in bass clef. Fingerings and breath marks are similarly placed.

E Melodic Minor Scale  $\bullet = 80$

The E Melodic Minor Scale is presented in 6/8 time with a tempo of 80. The first system consists of two staves: the left staff is in bass clef and the right staff is in treble clef. Fingerings are indicated by numbers 1-4 above or below notes. Breath marks (V) are placed above the first and fourth measures of each staff. The second system also consists of two staves: the left staff is in treble clef and the right staff is in bass clef. Fingerings and breath marks are similarly placed.
